Learn about this new HIPAA-compliant patient-driven health registry that answers two basic questions in a medical emergency:

1. What do emergency responders know about you, your allergies and medical needs?
2. How will your loved ones be notified?

What is Invisible Bracelet (iB)?



iB is a virtual medical ID bracelet that's not actually worn. Members carry multiple iB identifiers so that first responders and medical staff can access vital health information and notify emergency contacts during emergencies. Memberships are \$10 per year for consumers, and free for first responders and medical personnel.

- iB allows medical personnel to provide proactive care.
- iB improves the coordination and quality of EMS and hospital care.
- iB enables medics to instantly notify a patient's In Case of Emergency (ICE) contacts via text, email and automated voice response messaging when ambulance transport is necessary.

Invisible Bracelet (iB) facilitates important communication between patients and medical providers as well as patients and loved ones. iB is recognized nationwide by EMS providers. Learn how you can help bring this program to your area for the benefit of patients and the health care community.
